

What to pack?

Bedding (blanket or sleeping bag, pillow, sheet)

Child's medication, in a clear zip lock bag with instructions. This is to be handed in to our camp medical officer at camp.

If your child brings any electronics or expensive items, it is their responsibility to look after these over the duration of camp.

And just as a small reminder, don't forget to let us know of any medical information for your child over camp! If they require medication to be taken, please make this known on your camp registration form and ensure this medication gets handed to our camp medical officer on your child's arrival to camp.

FAQ'S

What are the sleeping arrangements?

Each young person will be allocated to a dorm based on their connect group and age. Girls and boys will be separated in separate building blocks located at opposite sides of the campsite. Leaders and volunteers will be sleeping in separate rooms together.

Are phones allowed and is there reception?

Yes, phones are allowed at camp and there is full reception on site. However, it is your child's responsibility to take care of any expensive belongings that they bring. We do not take responsibility for any lost, broken or stolen items.

In the spirit of being at youth camp and the nature of connecting with friends and being in the sessions, we ask that teenagers refrain from using phones regularly.

What activities are occurring over the course of youth camp?

A full and detailed itinerary of the camp will be provided in our parents information handbook. However, some of the things you can expect at camp are; camp sessions with praise and worship along with our guest speaker Ps Noah Walker from Planetboom, tribal championship games and activities, connect group sessions each morning, and a variety of 'chill out' zones for some down time in the afternoon.

My child has a medical condition, what should I do with this information?

On all of our registration forms, there is a section that you can complete, informing us of all the relevant information we need to know for your child.

We ask at camp, that your teenagers label any medication needed and hand it to our camp medical officer, who they can go to across the camp to take appropriate medication.

Can I drop my teenagers off directly to the campsite?

Yes, you are more than welcome to drop your child directly to the campsite. The details of the camp site and when we will be meeting are below;

FAQ'S part 2

Will my child need any spending money?

Your child does not need to bring any spending money to camp as all meals and activities are included in your camp registration costs. However, we will be taking up an offering at camp, if your child would like to give towards that offering.

What sort of supervision is exercised over camp?

At camp, we will have 35 leaders present, all over the age of 18 with relevant 'working with children' checks (blue cards). We will also have 'camp parents' on site at all times, who will be at the venue to assist with supervision. Along with this, we will also have a number of iSEE CHURCH staff members on site during the day as well. We also have a professional medical officer across the duration of camp, responsible for first aid & the allocation and use of medication.

Dietary Requirements:

From your child's rego form, this is passed onto the campsite to cater for your child's dietary needs. All meals are covered with dietary requirements, so please ensure this information is accurate on your child's rego form. If any dietary requirements change, please email youth@iseechurch.com. Each teenager with dietary needs, will get a different colour armband at camp to assist the camp team in ensuring their needs are met and provided for. We require all dietary information by June 25.

Payment Plan:

Payment plans are open to begin payment up until April 22. All payment plans must be paid in full by the start of Youth Camp on July 2.

Just a friendly reminder, that as per the registration form, you have agreed for your child to adhere to the guidelines set by our youth pastors, camp parents, regional leaders and youth leaders. If your child does not wish to adhere to these guidelines, we will be in contact with you and it will be your responsibility to pick up your child from our camp location at your cost.

We would also like to encourage our teenagers to come along to Encounter Conference from the 5-6 July. This is included in your teenager's youth camp registration. We will arrange transport if need be, so stay tuned!
